**NOTICE OF VACANCIES**

**IN OFFICE OF PARISH COUNCILLOR**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Section 87(2) of the Local Government Act 1972 that KEN BROWN and ALFRED FINNAMORE have ceased to be members of St Mabyn Parish Council and that two casual vacancies exists on the Council
2. If, within 14 days (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays) after the date of this Notice, a request for an election to fill the said vacancies is made in writing to the Returning Officer of Cornwall Council at 3S, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro TR1 3AY (phone 01209 614373) by TEN (or more) electors for the said Parish an election will be held to fill the vacancies.
3. If the Returning Officer receives fewer than ten written requests for an election by 8<sup>th</sup> October 2020 the Parish Council will fill the vacancies by co-option.
4. As a result of the Local Government and Police and Crime Commissioner (Coronavirus) (Postponement of Elections and Referendums) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020 and the Coronavirus Act 2020 should an election be requested, a poll cannot currently take place until 6 May 2021 (the date of the next ordinary elections) the vacancies will therefore be kept open and the Parish Council will be unable to fill the vacancies.
